## THE SECOND-YEAR WOC PORTFOLIO: FROM START TO SUBMIT

In *Brightspace*, self-enroll in the "WOC Portfolio Submission course" (all the support materials you'll need are in that course)

Work on writing and speaking assignments in FYS and Foundations classes

Make appointments at the **DWOC** Studio to get feedback, practice your presentations, and get help revising before final products are due in class

Add significant WOC assignments to My Items in Brightspace's ePortfolio for storage

During the semester in which you'll submit your portfolio, **choose appropriate items** from WOC Work Collection to include

Revise as needed, based on portfolio requirements; re-film presentations at DWOC and get feedback on written work to **revise and improve** 

Save finalized written documents as PDFs

Upload videos to YouTube (make sure privacy settings are set at "unlisted" or "public")

Download the Cover Letter template and ill in specifics about your portfolio contents

Save your cover letter and add to My Items as Word docs

In Brightspace's ePortfolio, create a New Presentation (name it "WOC Portfolio")

Add your 2 written assignments to Content Area 2; embed video links from YouTube

Download, complete and add the **2 forms** (Informed Consent and Statement of Authenticity) as PDFs to your WOC Portfolio in **Content Area 2** 

Cut and paste Cover Letter into Content Area 1 of your portfolio

Submit your WOC Portfolio to the correct Dropbox in the WOC Portfolio Submission course by 4pm on Fri., Dec. 16th
