Introduction

Purpose

The purpose of the Entering Student Questionnaire (ESQ) is to learn about the reasons first-year students chose the University of Mount Union, their experience during the admissions process, and to better understand the expectations they have for their academic careers and overall university experiences.

Survey Administration Methods

2024

The 2024 ESQ was made available via a QR code to 686 first-year undergraduate students attending their First Year Seminar (FYS) courses in the fall of 2024, the initial step of the general education Integrative Core (IC) Program at Mount Union. Students were introduced to the ESQ by their FYS instructors during the first week of September. Additionally, the ESQ was directly emailed to FYS students. A total of 347 students completed the 2024 ESQ. The FYS instructors' encouragement, and the leadership of the IC director, were instrumental in achieving a 50.6% response rate for 2024.

The 2024 ESQ is composed of 13 multiple choice questions. It was revised to include four new questions (Q9-Q12) to determine students' methods of interacting with the University and the level and effectiveness of communication during the admission process.
