To begin the internal and external application process, **students must meet the following eligibility requirements:**

Eligibility Requirements:

Class Standing

Students must be enrolled as one of the following:

- **Sophomore**
- **Junior**
- **Senior**

Academic Requirements

- **Minimum cumulative GPA: 2.75**
 - *This can be found on your unofficial transcript in Self-Service*
- **Good academic standing** with the University
 - Please see the [University Catalog](#) for additional information
- Meet the requirements for an academic internship within your major department

Financial Requirements

- **Good financial standing** with the University

International Student Requirement

- Demonstrated English proficiency
 - **TOEFL iBT score of 80+** or equivalent English language qualification
