## **Relay for Life**

Mount Union's Relay for Life committee works together during the school year to arrange a 12-hour event to raise money for research and programs for the American Cancer Society. During the event, team members walk laps and participate in activities to raise as much money as possible. There are many different ways to be involved in this event. Anyone can be a part of the committee, a team, or donate money to the organization. Mount Union's Relay for Life is scheduled for March 27-28, 2020.

#### **Up 'til Dawn**

Mount Union has raised more than \$560,000 for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital by participating in Up 'til Dawn over the past ten years. In the fall, students form teams to send letters to family and friends on behalf of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Then, in the spring, students once again come together to celebrate the mission of St. Jude as well as the work they have done for the cause by revealing the total money raised by Mount Union at the finale event. Most importantly, students learn about philanthropy and working together to impact the common good!
