Use these instructions to request your IRS Tax Transcripts or Confirmation of Non-Filing Letter by mail or online.

1. Receive your transcript by mail.

Alternative to Requesting a Transcript Online

We recommend requesting a transcript online, since that's the fastest method. If you can't get your transcript online, you can request one by mail instead.

What You Need

To request a transcript by mail, you need your mailing address from your latest return.

What You Get


- · Tax Return or Tax Account transcript types delivered by mail
- If you need your prior year Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) to e-file, choose the tax return transcript type when making your request.
- Transcripts arrive in 5 to 10 calendar days at the address we have on file for you


Get Transcript by Mail

You can also request a transcript by mail by calling our automated phone transcript service at 800-908-9946.

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Follow the instructions provided.







When you complete the process, it will take 5-10 days to receive the transcript in the mail.


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2. Request your transcript online.


Order copies of tax records including transcripts of past tax returns, tax account information, wage and income statements and non-filer letters.

If you want to find out how much you owe, verify your payment history, get your prior year Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) to efile or see other tax information, you may not need a transcript. View this information in $\underline{your\ tax\ account}$ instead.

The method you used to file your tax return (e-file or paper) and whether you had a balance due affects your <u>current year transcript availability</u>.



You will need to log in or create an account. Once logged in, follow the screens below. You will need your government issued ID, computer and cell phone to complete the process.



IRS Tax Transcripts/Verification of Non-Filing Letter

You will choose Higher Education/Student Aid for the reason and click "GO". You will then choose "Return Transcript" from the appropriate year. Once you select the appropriate year, a PDF will open with your transcript or verification of non-filing letter.
