ArtFest will be held at its historic location around the Campus Lakes of the University of Mount Union. Scheduled in conjunction with the Mount Union vs. John Carroll football game, Mount Union's Family Day, and the Carnation City Food Truck Rally, ArtFest 2018 will be part of a bustling day on campus. In recent years, ArtFest has hosted more than 50 vendors and 3,000 visitors.

Original Works

Artists who have not been in our show previously or within the last five years must submit three photographs or slides of their work, marked with name and medium to artfest@mountunion.edu. The ArtFest committee also reviews work during the event, which may affect eligibility for the following year.

Only one exhibitor is permitted per booth space. In addition, the committee reserves the right to ask artists to remove any work that does not meet the standards or that is not representative of the work in the photos submitted for jurying. Only original works will be accepted.

Juror

Jack Carlton, instructor of printmaking at Hiram College, is this year's juror. Carlton earned his B.F.A. in sculpture and M.A. in painting at Kent State University and his M.F.A. in printmaking from the School of the Boston Museum of Fine Arts and Tufts University. Carlton has traveled around the world making, teaching, and selling art and producing monoprints, collagraphs and sculptures. Carlton's works can be viewed in museums in New York, Massachusetts, Ohio, and various locations around the United States and other countries.

Categories

Fine Art: watercolor/acrylic (under glass), oil/acrylic (without glass), photography, collage, printmaking, graphics, drawing, pastels, and sculpture.

Functional Craft: jewelry, fiber, woodworking, glass, enameling, lights, mirrors, purses/bags, candles, soaps, etc. Functional art and/or craft has a specific utility yet it is creative either in its purpose or aesthetic appearance.

Set Up and Booths

Set up is from 7 to 9:30 a.m. Judging begins at 11 a.m. Registrants will receive an acceptance package via email that will include additional set up, registration and specific location information. Display panels are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Artists are responsible for furnishing their own tables, chairs, canopies, etc.

Exhibitors should stay with their work. If you must leave temporarily, some booth sitters will be available.
