Mount Union Once Again Named A Top College, Best Value by U.S. News and World Report

For the 29th consecutive year, the University of Mount Union has been recognized as a top college by U.S. News and World Report.



Mount Union was ranked 13th among Midwest Regional Colleges in U.S. News and World Report's 2020 Best Colleges rankings. The Midwest Regional category includes institutions from Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota and Wisconsin.

The institution was also ranked ninth for Best Value, which takes into account the ratio of quality to price, the percentage of undergraduates that receive need-based aid, and the total scholarship/need-based aid received by students. Read more [here!](#)

Financial Aid and Billing

Through student employment, our students have the opportunity to earn money while gaining experience to prepare them for employment after graduation. There are a variety of openings across campus, as well as some Federal Work Study community service positions with local non-profit organizations. All current openings can be found in the [*Student Job Book](#) in iRaider under “Quick Links.” Student employment is a great chance to build skills and a resume while providing support to the university and community.

The Office of Business Affairs wants to make sure you are aware of dates that will be of importance to you and your student:

- Payment for fall semester is now overdue. Accounts with outstanding balances will be charged a late fee of 1%. If you are awaiting scholarship money, please contact them directly to confirm when we should receive the funds.
- Accounts with balances above \$500 have been placed on hold. This means your student will not have access to view grades or register for the spring 2020 semester. Transcripts will not be released to any account on hold. Accounts with balances at or below \$500 or those that are up to date on their monthly payment plan are considered current.

Parking and Vehicles

The University of Mount Union permits students to have and park their cars on campus. Parking is \$100 per academic year for commuter, residential, and graduate students.
