



FAQ's of Face Coverings-from the Ohio Department of Health Director's Order

Facial Coverings (Masks) Required at All Times:

1. Do I need to wear them indoors?
 - a. Yes, in any indoor location unless it is a residence.
2. Do I need to wear a face covering outdoors?
 - a. Yes, outdoors when unable to consistently maintain a distance of six feet or more from individuals who are not members of a family or household.
3. Do I need to wear a face covering when driving or riding in a vehicle?
 - a. If waiting for, riding, driving or operating public transportation (taxi, car service, ride sharing vehicles, bus) you must wear a face covering.
 - b. The face covering rule does not apply to private or rental vehicles where members of a family/household are sharing a vehicle.
4. Does my child need to wear a face covering?
 - a. The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) will be writing an order that K-12 students are required to wear them in schools. Those 2 years old and under will not be required to wear them.
5. When I am working out, do I need to wear a face covering?
 - a. If you are actively engaged in the gym or indoor facility; as long as you are six feet or more away from another individual, you do not need to wear a face covering.
6. Do my student athletes need to wear a face covering when participating in practice, scrimmage and/or games?
 - a. No, unless it is required by a separate Ohio Department of Health order.
7. Do I need to wear a face covering while attending a religious service?
 - a. Yes, only an officiant of a religious service is not required to wear one.
8. Do I need to wear a face covering while I teach and/or attend class?
 - a. Yes, all staff, faculty and students are required to wear a face covering in class under the current mask mandate.
