  - Used as a verification for Mount logins. Do not delete the app. It will be needed when you try
    to access your accounts from off campus. If you change phones, please contact the IT Helpdesk
    to transition your account to your new phone.



- Mount provides this service free for all students including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Teams,
  OneDrive etc. These are free to you as long as you are a Mount Union student. There is no
  reason to purchase this on your own. Make sure that you are familiar with these applications
  as everything is cloud-based

- SpectrumU is free for all students to watch TV
  - Roku TVs, Smart TVs, Chromecast, laptop logins all function. Some stations will work from off campus as well

- Navigate to <u>MyWCO</u>
  - o You will have to create an account with a password of ten characters or more

- <u>Password resets</u> are required every 90 days. When you log into one of our applications a link to the password reset is below. You can choose Forgot my password and walk through the prompts.



- Wifi is available across campus
  - o UMU Personal
    - You will receive an email with the password prior to the start of classes from Extreme Networks. This password should be used for all of your devices. Do not share it with others.
  - UMU Guest
    - Do not use this network. Not all of your resources will be available from it. UMU –
       Personal should be used for all students.

- \*No personal routers to connect devices extenders
