# LIVING ON CAMPUS

#### FILL OUT THE NEW STUDENT HOUSING OR COMMUTER FORM

- Log in to <u>MyHousing</u>
- Navigate to "Apps & Forms" then "New Student Housing or Commuter Application"
- Read and consent to the Residential Housing Contract (even commuters)
- Fill out information and preferences
- Add emergency contacts
- Rank Residence Hall preferences
- Select a Dining Plan based on the options provided. Transfer students and commuter students have different options than First Year students

## **RESIDENCE HALLS**

- Cunningham and McCready Halls are co-ed by floor
- Ketcham, Miller, and King Halls are designated for males
- McMaster Hall is designated for females
- Elliott Hall is gender inclusive

UNION

 The Honors clusters are in McMaster, Ketcham, and Elliott Halls

# **IMPORTANT INFO**

- Residence Hall *preferences* are not guarantees
- UMU has a 2 year residency requirement unless students are commuting or have transferred to UMU.
- For Housing purposes, "First Year" student status is based on the number of years at UMU not credit status
- First Year students cannot "buy out" a room (everyone will have a roommate)
- First Year students will live in traditional halls with communal bathrooms and no air unless they have an accommodation through <u>Student Accessibility Services</u>
- It costs \$85 to replace lost keys

### ROOMMATES

- Once two students complete their forms and request each other on MyHousing by 7/15, they will be paired
- Students on sports teams or in an interest group can request to live with another member. UMU Staff should make suggestions to students, not to the Office of Residence Life
- If a student does not request a roommate, they will be paired with one based off of preferences from the form
- Honors clusters are available for students in the Honors Program even if their roommate is non-Honors

#### COMMUTERS & TRANSFERS

- If a student lives within 30 miles of their permanent address, they may commute. This is **not** the same as living off-campus, which is not allowed for two years
- Transfer students will be accommodated on a case-by-case basis
